### Craft & Game Ideas

#### **Craft Ideas**

#### 1. You are Welcome

The Bible tell us that Jesus welcomes everyone back when they come to him. Make a welcome sign to help you tell others that they are welcome too!

#### You will need:

- String
- Glue
- Empty cereal boxes (or other cardboard)
- Random fun stuff (e.g. pipe cleaners, bottle caps)



#### Instructions:

- 1. Have a look around the house for fun things you can use to make your sign! Maybe try looking in the recycling (But make sure to check if you can use them).
- 2. Start by cutting out the base of the sign that you can stick everything else onto.
- **3.** Put a hole in both corners of the sign and tie string to each hole. (This is so you can hang up your sign)
- **4.** Use whatever you have to make the words "You Are Welcome" on the sign. Stick on anything you want to use for each letter.
- 5. And you can be as creative as you like you could even draw or paint a sign!
- **6.** Hang up your sign where people can see and don't forget to tell them that Jesus welcomes everyone back when they come to him.



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### 2. Sheep

Even though Simon Peter let Jesus down, Jesus welcomed him back and gave Simon Peter the task of sharing his message of forgiveness - "feed my sheep." If we follow Jesus, he wants us to share his message too!

#### You will need:


- Sheep template (see below)
- Glue
- Cotton wool
- Coloured pencils (if you want to colour in the sheep)

#### Instructions:

- 1. Print out the sheep template. If you don't have a printer, have a go at drawing your own!
- 2. Glue cotton wool onto your sheep or colour it in!
- 3. Stick your sheep on the wall or fridge (or maybe even give it to a friend).



Again Jesus said, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" He answered, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Take care of my sheep."



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#### **Game Ideas**

#### 1. Who am !?

#### You will need:

- A headband (either make your own with strips of cardboard/paper or use a child's headband if it's big enough)
- Spare pieces of paper to write peoples names on (to attach to headband)
- List of names that people in your family will know. Either family, friends, cartoon characters etc. Last 2 names to be used need to be Peter (from the story) and Jesus.

#### Instructions:

- 1. Choose someone to go first.
- 2. Write the names of the people you are going to guess on the spare paper, cut them out and attach one of them to the headband.
- 3. The player then asks yes/no questions to guess who is on their head.
- 4. Other players are only allowed to answer yes/no.
- 5. Questions like "Is this person real?", "Are they still alive?", "Are they in the bible?", "Are they a boy or girl?" etc. Give hints to younger kids. To make it harder, give a question limit of 20.
- **6.** Once the person has been guessed, choose a new player and attach a new name to headband.

#### 2. Memory Game

#### You will need:

2 sets of playing cards (see below)

### Instructions:

- 1. Print and cut out cards (2 sets of pictures).
- 2. Shuffle cards.
- 3. Lay the cards picture side down in grid setup.
- 4. Choose someone to begin play.
- **5.** Turn over 2 cards. If they don't match then turn cards back over and it's the next player's turn.
- 6. If cards do match then the same player has another turn.
- 7. Play till all cards have been matched up. Player with most cards wins.
